



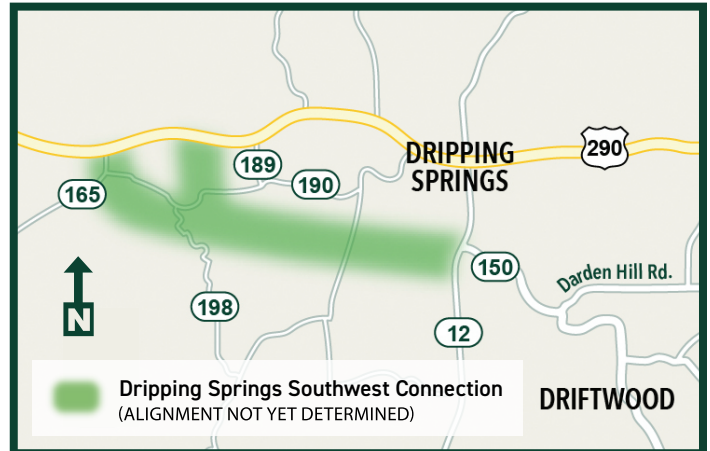
Dripping Springs Southwest Connection Study

Conducted by Hays County

As part of a continued effort to improve transportation and mobility in our community, Hays County is conducting a study to identify a route that will extend RM 150 from the intersection of RM 12 at RM 150 and connect to US 290 west of Dripping Springs.

THE STUDY AIMS TO:

- » Proactively plan for current and future traffic levels
- » Work with stakeholders and property owners during the planning process
- » Identify the proposed route and right-of-way needs
- » Develop preliminary engineering plans (20% design) to inform future budgeting and planning efforts



BACKGROUND:

The need for this connection was identified by previous studies, which are listed below.

- » **Hays County Transportation Plan**
 - 2013 plan identified needed connection at Roger Hanks Parkway
 - 2021 plan identifies needed connection farther west
- » **RM 150 Character Plan**
 - Completed in 2017, identified preference for roundabout at RM 12 and RM 150
- » **City of Dripping Springs Transportation Master Plan 2014 and 2018**
 - Identifies a possible connection at Holder Lane and 290
